WCYS: The Washington Center held a seminar on ZOOM to launch its new book, "Yemen Conflict". Speakers at the seminar were the former US Ambassador to Yemen, Michael Gerald Firston, Hooria Mashhour, the former Minister of Human Rights, the book author, translator and editor. [For more](#)



WCYS: Yemen's internationally recognised government and the Houthi rebels agreed to exchange about 1,000 detainees and prisoners, including 15 Saudis, as part of trust-building steps aimed at reviving a stalled peace process, the United Nations said.



WCYS: A rusting oil-storage vessel moored off Yemen's Red Sea coast could rupture or explode, Western officials said, warning of an environmental and humanitarian catastrophe if it breaks apart.



WCYS:
Democratic presidential candidate, Joe Biden, has pledged to end his country's support for Saudi Arabia's war in Yemen if he becomes president.



WCYS: The paper quoted sources as saying that the Saudi Foreign Minister, Faisal Bin Farhan, spoke on the phone with his Russian counterpart, Sergey Lavrov, and asked him to mediate between the kingdom and the Houthis to stop the group from advancing towards Marib.



WCYS: Prime Minister Justin Trudeau is facing fresh calls to end arms exports to Saudi Arabia after a United Nations panel named Canada for the first time as one of the countries helping fuel the war in Yemen.



WCYS: U.S. Congress is urging the State Department to reconsider U.S. assistance to Yemen suspended by President Donald Trump's administration earlier this year after a plea from humanitarian groups last month appeared to fall on deaf ears, redoubling attention on years of U.S. policy missteps in the war-torn country.



WCYS: Yemen's warring sides complete largest prisoner swap in 5 years More than 1,000 people released following prisoner exchange between government and Houthi fighters.



WCYS: Saudi's envoy to Yemen appoints ministers in the war-torn country and "treats Yemenis as subordinates", the Deputy Speaker of Parliament Abdul Aziz Jabbari has said.

WCYS: The Trump administration is considering new steps to intensify pressure on Yemen's Houthi rebels, including a potential foreign terrorist organization designation, according to several officials, in a bid to further isolate the group's patron, Iran.
